### Studio Oreka: Where Context Meets Creativity

Along the storied coastline of Saint-Tropez, where azure waters meet timeless elegance, designer David Granata has established Studio Oreka as a beacon of contemporary hospitality design. This trans-disciplinary architecture atelier is quietly revolutionizing the luxury landscape of the French Riviera.

Each commission—whether an intimate villa perched above the Mediterranean or a destination restaurant alive with coastal energy—begins with a deep study of place. Yet what emerges is never pastiche. # MOODY ELEGANCE

In the heart of Brooklyn's historic Boerum Hill neighborhood, Barker Architecture Office has completed a dramatic renovation of a 19th-century townhouse, creating a residence where moody sophistication meets sculptural form. Designed for a social family of three, the 278-square-meter home spans four levels and maximizes every corner for entertaining and hosting guests.

Led by Alexandra Barker, FAIA, LEED AP, the award-winning firm embraced a design language of deep colors, curved architectural elements, and richly veined marbles that transforms the traditional brownstone typology. The project, unveiled in early 2025, represents a fresh approach to Brooklyn townhouse living—one that balances historical character with contemporary boldness.

From the entry, the home's personality is immediately apparent. Walls painted in Farrow and Ball's Green Smoke surround a playful green and pink checkerboard floor, reimagining the classic black-and-white pattern. A custom asymmetrical mirror echoes the arched doorway, introducing the sculptural vocabulary that flows throughout the residence.
